

REACH implementation

On June 1st, 2007 the Regulation 2006/1907/EC (REACH-Regulation) was coming into force.

REACH harmonizes the chemical legislation for Europe. This law brings new obligations for us. For this reason, fischer has implemented a project team. fischer is regarded as a „Downstream User“ under REACH, i. e. fischer is not committed to register any substances. But we have assured that our suppliers have (pre-) registered all relevant raw materials in time.

Another duty of REACH is to give information about so called “SVHC-substances” in products. “SVHC” means **S**ubstance of **V**ery **H**igh **C**oncern. These substances are specified in the candidate list¹. If a SVHC is contained above 0,1 % (w/w) in the product, fischer has to communicate this to you.

Concerning Article 33 we disclose the following:

Since 27.06.2018 dicyclohexyl phthalate (CAS-No. 84-61-7) has been added to the candidate list. This substance is included in the following fischer resin capsules.


